As part of its convergence program, the Saudi Organisation for Certified Public Accountants (SOCPA) has announced its intent to apply International Financial Reporting. Listed entities would be required to report their financial statements under the converged standards for financial periods beginning on or after 1 January 2017. For other entities the earliest date for application shall be for financial periods beginning on or after 1 January 2018.

Structure of Course Programme

This is a modularized course programme, which will comprise a mixture of lectures, questions and answer sessions, practical exercises and real-life illustrations. Delegates will receive full course materials including practical examples and illustrations.

The course will be conducted in Arabic.
