Top energy projects in Egypt

Egypt's power sector is the cornerstone of inclusive development, and expected to have more than 43 billion EGP worth of public investment for the power sector during 2021/2022, and around 416 renewable energy projects worth 95.6 billion EGP in two years. Energy sector represents **13.1%** of overall GDP



Egypt needs **EGP 2 Trillion** in climate-smart investments alone by 2030



Energy consumption per capita was at **0.97 toe**, including **1550 kWh** of electricity (2019)



Egypt intends to increase the supply of electricity generated from renewable sources to **20%** by 2022 and **42%** by 2035



Households absorb **41%** of energy consumption, followed by industry (**29%**) and services (**20%**)



Egypt to deliver **7.2 GW** of wind power by 2022, **2.8 GW** of solar CSP by 2027 and **700 MW** of PV by 2027



Investment in renewable energy capacity, currently set at around **EGP 39.5 billion** per year until 2030

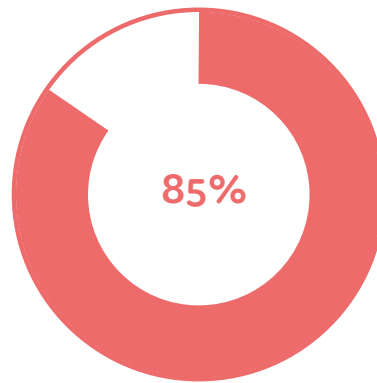
